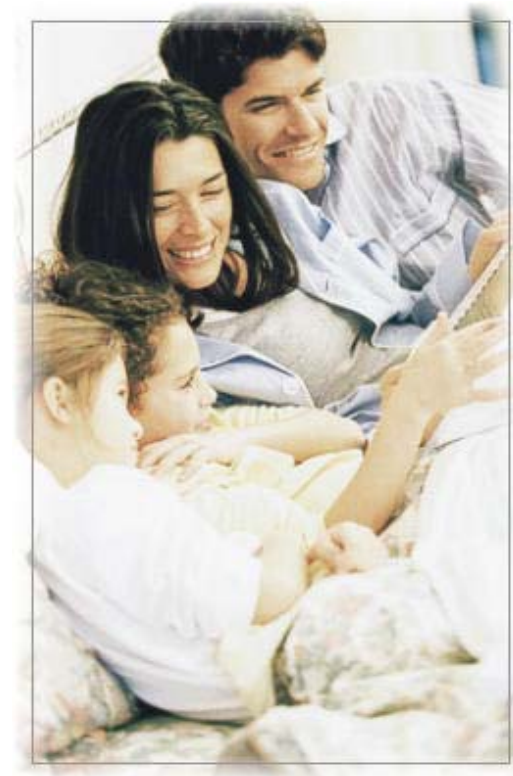

Our Lutheran Stance

ALC employs the traditional law/gospel distinction in our proclamation of God's Word. In Summary:

We believe, teach, and confess the Triune God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – three distinct Persons in one Godhead. Jesus Christ alone is Lord and Savior. The gospel is the power of God for the salvation of all who believe in Him. We believe, teach and confess the Gospel that we are justified by grace alone, that is, by faith alone through Christ alone as the heart and center of the Holy Scriptures, the ecumenical creeds and the Lutheran confessional writings. We believe, teach, and accept the canonical Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments as the sole authoritative source and norm of our proclamation, faith, and life. We accept the Apostles', Nicene, and Athanasian Creeds as true declarations of the scriptures. We believe, teach, and accept the Unaltered Augsburg Confession and the Small Catechism as true witnesses to the Word of God, normative for our teaching and practice. We believe, teach, and accept the other confessional writings in the Book of Concord, namely, the Apology of the Augsburg Confession, the Smalcald Articles, the Treatise, the Large Catechism, and the Formula of Concord, as further valid expositions of the Holy Scriptures.
